

Your Information

The personal data collected on this form will be held securely and will only be used for administrative purposes. We will commit to processing information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Shinnyo-en Privacy Policy.

Your Images

To provide a general visual record of our event, photos and videos, including interviews with guests will be taken. Images are taken on our behalf by one or more photographers and processed by us and the photographer. It may be possible that you can be identified directly or indirectly in the photographs and recordings, hence can be regarded as personal data in the sense of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

In the following, we will inform you about how, for what purposes and for what duration the recordings are processed and what rights you have in this respect, in particular with regard to the GDPR.

Responsible for the data processing is:

Shinnyo-en – UK

The photos are taken for Shinnyo-en as an organizer and used and published for internal communication purposes in the association or Shinnyo-en group (i.e. the worldwide Shinnyo-en associations and temples) (for example in brochures, magazines and on the intranet). In addition, the videos and photos for post-reporting and external communication purposes are published on our media platforms such as YouTube, Facebook or our websites. Data processing takes place on the basis of our legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f GDPR. The processing is required in particular to promote and document the event amongst members and non-members.

The photos are retained for 5 years. An exception applies to photographs that have a historical value and are permanently archived for use in future historical publications - such as the association's history.

When publishing photos on any of our social media channels we cannot exclude the transmission of such photos to a country outside the EU. The social media services we use are certified under the EU / US Privacy Shield Agreement and are required to comply with GDPR regulations.

If the photos are transmitted to a country outside the EU within the other Shinnyo-en entities, this is done on the basis of adequate protection including transfers to countries the data protection level of which has been recognized by the EU through a formal adequacy decision (such as e.g. Japan) or under so-called "Standard Contract Clauses" (SCCs).

You have the right,

- according to Art. 15 GDPR, to request information about your personal data processed by us;
- according to Art. 16 GDPR, to immediately demand the correction of incorrect or completed personal data stored with us;
- according to Art. 17 GDPR, to require the deletion of your personal data stored with us, unless the processing for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, to fulfill a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or is required for the assertion, exercise or defense of legal rights;
- according to Art. 18 GDPR, to require the restriction of the processing of your personal data, as far as the accuracy of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful, but you reject the deletion, we no longer need the data, but you require this to assert, exercise or Defense of legal claims., or under Art. 21 GDPR you have filed an objection against the processing;
- according to Art. 77 GDPR, to complain to a supervisory authority. In general, you can contact the data protection authorities of your usual place of residence or work or company headquarters.

You have the right, in accordance with Art. 21 GDPR to object to the processing of your personal data, as far as there are reasons for this arising from your particular situation. Your personal data will then no longer be processed unless the organizer as controller can prove compelling reasons for processing that outweigh the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or the processing is for the purpose of asserting, exercising or defending legal claims.
